REGISTRATION:

- Open March-April. (*March 1-15 for church members & regular attenders only.*)
- Registration will close on May 1st.
- Limited spaces per grade level. Encourage friends and family members to register right away!

DATES: June 25-29, 2018

AGES: K-6th Graders (entering grade for Fall 2018)

TIMES:

- 9:00-11:30 am: K-1st grade
- 9:00am-4:00 pm: 2nd-6th grade

CAMP FEE:

- \$75 for K-1st grade
- \$150 for 2nd-6th grade
- Additional fees for extended childcare. [LIMITED SPACES!]
 - \$20/child per week - early drop off (7:30 am)
 - \$20/child per week - late pick-up up (\$1 per minute after 5:30 pm)
- Camp Fee includes: camp t-shirt, daily snacks, Friday pizza party, luau family dinner, special guest entertainers, minimal costume, practice CD, craft, game, set, and prop supplies.
- Scholarships are available upon approval.

DAILY CAMP ROUTINES:

What to Wear

- Come in your comfortable and appropriate play clothes.
- Wear shoes for running. Tennis shoes, preferred, but sandals that do not slip-off easily will be fine.
- Please apply sunscreen BEFORE you arrive. Most of our time spent outside is in the morning, but if your child will need additional applications, please send a labeled bottle of sunscreen with him or her.

Drop-Off

- All children should arrive by 9:00 am.
- The extended MORNING childcare is only for K-6th graders who registered and paid the additional fee. Please do NOT arrive before 8:50 a.m. if your child is not a part of this childcare group.
- **All children should check-in & be picked-up DAILY BY AN ADULT ONLY** (not an older sibling). Yes, even for regular church attendees!
- Please check-in with the grade level leaders at the child's designated section in the Church Sanctuary as you arrive.
- **2nd-6th graders will sign-up in the foyer DAILY upon arrival** for their choice of "**Break-Out Sessions**" for that day. (See details below)

Pick-Up

- K-1st graders should be picked-up daily promptly at 11:30 am.
- 2nd-6th graders should be picked-up daily at 4:00 pm.
- The extended AFTERNOON childcare is for 2nd-6th graders only.
- For those in the later childcare group, please be mindful of the \$1.00 per minute late fee after 5:30 pm. For the afternoon childcare group, we will have the children available for a drive-up pick-up at the front glass doors for your convenience.
- Parents, on the first day of camp, you will submit a "**Pick-Up Password**". Whoever picks up your child, will be asked this "password" by your child's leader EACH DAY.
- **PLEASE BE PUNCTUAL** for BOTH drop-off & pick-up times.

Snacks / Lunch

- K-1st graders will receive a daily snack each morning. These youngsters will be picked-up before lunchtime.
- **2nd-6th ONLY....Please BRING a LABELED SACK LUNCH daily** (except Friday when we enjoy a pizza party!) Please place your lunch on the appropriate tables labeled by grade level in the back of the Sanctuary as you arrive.
- *****We strive to be a NUT-FREE camp. PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANYTHING WITH NUTS, including PEANUT BUTTER!!!*****

Camp Activities

- Camp activities will include Bible lessons, games, crafts, music, snacks, costume/prop/set making, outdoor rec fun, mission projects, entertainment by special guests, and many new camp activities we've never had before!
- 2nd-6th graders will sign-up DAILY upon arrival for their choice of "Break-Out Sessions" for that day. These sessions will include a variety of "summer camp" type activities to increase the fun and broaden the skills of our campers! We hope as you meet new faces through this exciting week, you will try these exciting adventures with your new friends.
- K-1st graders will also have age-appropriate "Break-Out Sessions", but will be assigned their specific activity in small groups each day in to be sure all of these youngsters get a chance to participate in each activity throughout the week.
- We look forward to presenting a musical performance of "Splash Kingdom: A Life-Saving Musical for Kids" on Friday evening at the Summerfest Luau!
- Children who have a strong aversion to singing will not be expected to perform with the choir in the show but will be encouraged to participate in some other way behind-the-scenes.
- Only those who attend camp every day will be given the opportunity to be selected for a special speaking or singing role.

Safety & Security

- For the safety of all our campers, our entire Camp Staff completes a 5-step Ministry Safe training, including reference and background checks.
- Our camp is CLOSED to any youth or adults who are NOT serving on the Camp Staff. Parents, please plan to drop-off and pick-up at the assigned times without staying throughout the day.
- In case of an emergency, call 254-751-0411 to reach your child.
