Care bags filled with hygiene and snack kits. Bags are distributed at the Waco Bus Station to women who are released from prison on the same day. Many have nothing and are traveling away from the area. This is a joint ministry with other churches who also spend time asking women their prayer requests and who spend time praying with them while they are waiting to leave. With their permission prayer requests are sent to our members who are on the church's prayer chain email.

Supply their food pantry for those living in poverty. For the **GREAT DAY OF SERVICE** we will request **Bags of Beans/Rice and Canned Goods**. May purchase ahead of time. **Only bring to the church on this day!**
